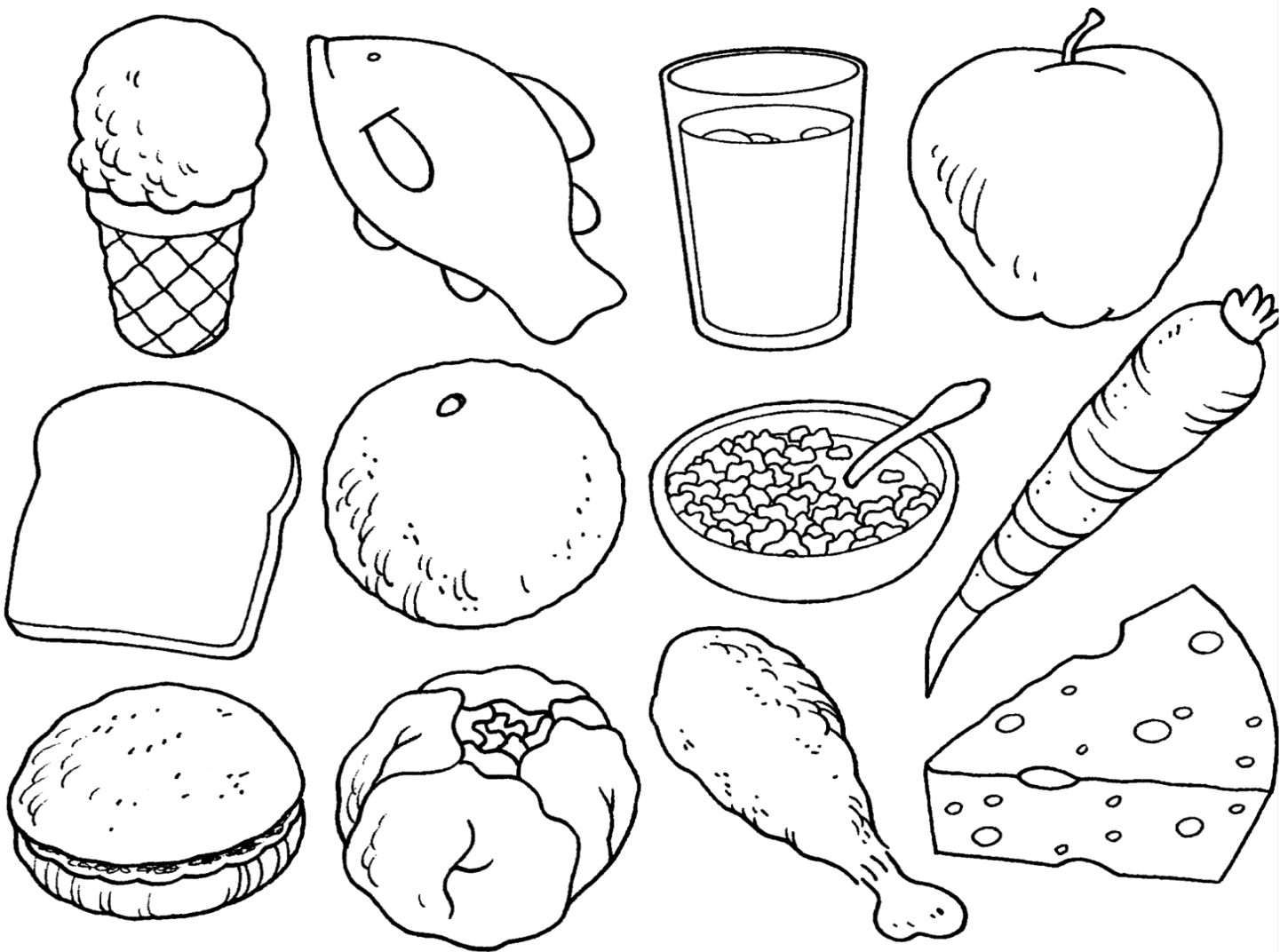


Daniel 1 Daniel Obeys God

Color the foods you like to eat.

Why not try some of the foods that you did not color?
You might like them too!



Read Daniel 1 verses

- What food is Daniel and his friends eat?
- Would you like to eat just vegetables and drink water?
- Would food would you miss eating?

WHAT CAN WE DO TO PLEASE GOD?

Right or Wrong?

Divide your lounge/living room into two parts. Tell your family that one side of the room is the “right” side and the other side is the “wrong” side.

I’m going to say some things that God says are right to do and some things that God says is wrong to do. If what I say is wrong, move to the wrong side of the room. If what I say is right, move to the right side of the room. Listen carefully and make good choices. Use the following statements and add more of your own:

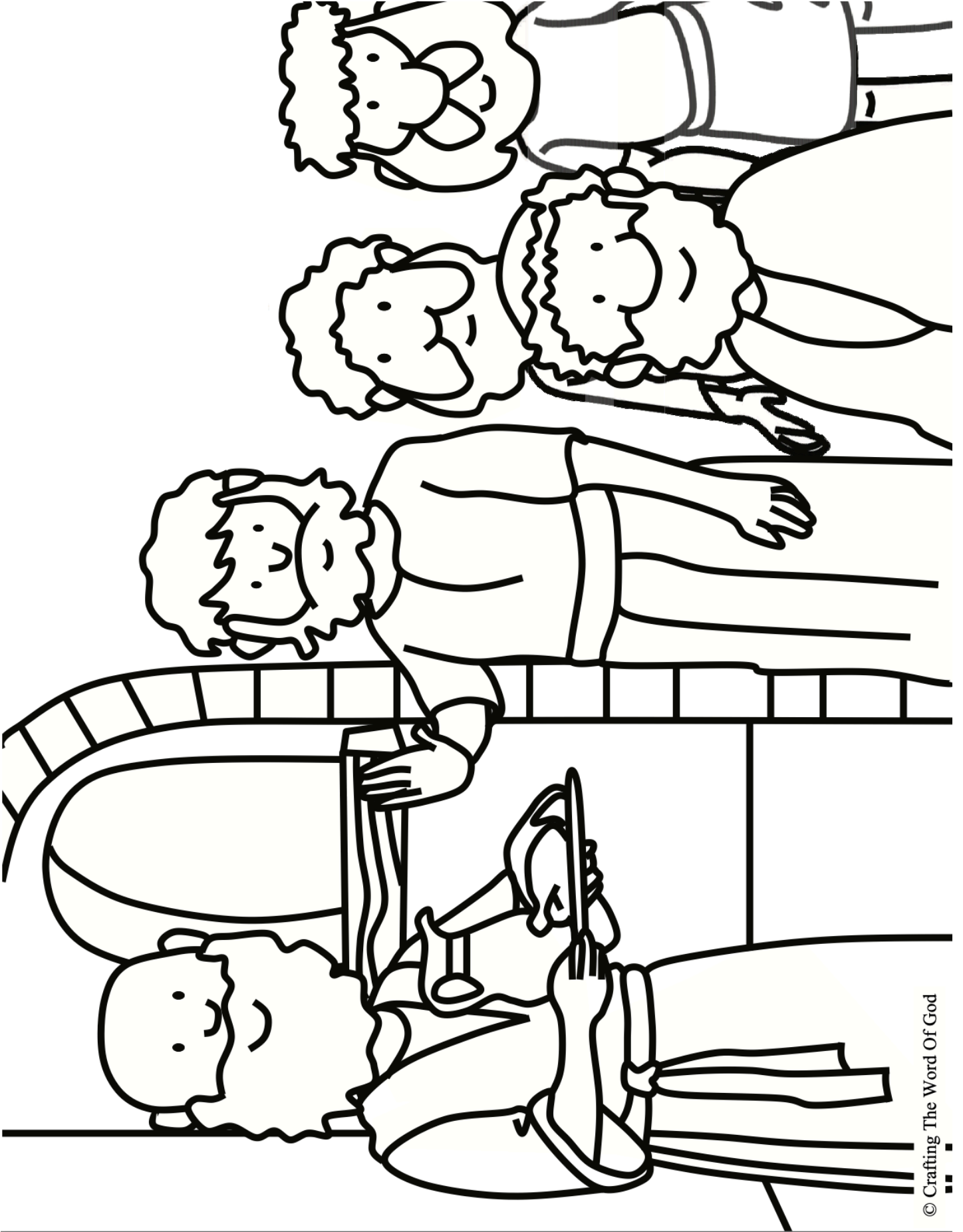
- Obey your parents.
- Cheat on tests.
- Eat a lot of junk food.
- Talk back to your parents.
- Be kind to others.
- Gossip about kids you don’t like.
- Tell the truth.
- Show love to others.
- Want everything your friends have.
- Be happy with what you have.
- Be patient with your brothers and sisters.

I’m glad you know the difference between right and wrong. You’re obeying God when you make good choices. Listen carefully to this last sentence and decide if this is a right or wrong thing to do: “You can pray anywhere and anytime.” Pause for children to move to the “right” side of the room.

Great! Now that we’re all standing on the right side of the room, let’s pray.

Lead the children in a prayer asking God’s help in making good choices. Give each child a turn to pray.

Model a sentence like this: **Dear God, thank You for all the good things You give us. Help me obey You by making good choices this week.**
